## St. Peter's Parish Mission Statement

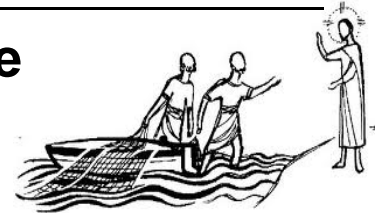
