All Catholics who have reached their 14th birthday are bound to abstain entirely from meat on **Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent**. All Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to observe the laws of **fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday**. Fasting means limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals. Two other light meals, which together do not equal a full meal, may be taken during the day.

"A Kindness a Day during Lent"

Simple reminder of how you may wish to enrich your Lenten journey through the undertaking of simple Acts of Kindness.
