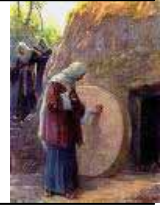

Update on Mount Calvary Cemetery 125th Anniversary Projects

As highlighted by Fr. McNally on July 3 & 4, the fundraising campaign to support the three initial projects at the Cemetery is going very well. To date \$134,000 has been contributed, with an additional \$13,000 pledged. The chain link fence at the front of the cemetery has been removed, & the replacement iron fence is in the process of being prepared for installation. When the eight stone pillars – currently being constructed – are completed, the fence and gates will be installed. The cost of this phase, including HST, is close to \$100,000. The design & pricing for the columbarium/niche wall project is underway and hopefully the first unit will be installed before fall. Likewise, the proper display of the heritage grave stones is in the planning stage. The generous spirit of all donors is appreciated, as ongoing support will be required to complete these projects and ensure that the cemetery is well maintained into the future.

Property & Maintenance Matters

Fr. McNally also made reference on July 3 & 4 to the maintenance and improvement projects that he and the Finance Committee have recently approved. To be completed in the coming weeks, they include: removal and replacement of all shingles, installation of aluminum facial & eaves troughs on the **rectory roof**; removal of the current concrete steps and construction of new ground level **entrances** (north & south sides) of the **church**; repairs to, and capping of, the steps leading into the **central entrance** of the church, with installation of hand railings; replacement of outdoor carpeting leading to the entrance to the Adoration Chapel in the **Parish Centre**.
